VALENCIA — Valencia-based U.S. HealthWorks, which operates outpatient health-care centers for the treatment of work-related injuries and urgent care needs, announced Monday that ex-California Gov. Pete Wilson has joined its board.

"I am looking forward to working with the leadership of U.S. HealthWorks as the firm enters a new growth phase," Wilson said in a statement released by the company.

"As a partner in helping employers maintain healthy and productive workforces, the company plays an important role in the American economy," said California's 36th governor, who served from 1991 to 1999.

U.S. HealthWorks, which was founded in 1995, in January announced the completion of a \$175 million financing package that will support the company in its ongoing occupational health clinic acquisition strategy.
